Governor Hebert, of Louisiana, who owned a thousand slaves before the year, who fought for the Confederacy at Getryshurg, after the war in an open letter, approved by General Beauregard, made a vain appeal to the South not to make an ass of tiself by factious and malignant personution of the negro. The South lacks "horse senee;" it is brave, bright, eloquent, convivint, full of talent and virility, but it behaves too much like a man with a stilly woman's head; it lacks common acuse; it fights the inevitable and wastes its health and its strength in trying to prove that the world moves backward and war doesn't logislate. Of course this color projudice is not due to physical repulsion between the races, for the South never grows weary of white washing the pure negro into the plebald shape of mulattoes, quadroons and octoroons; the aristocratic South before the war was as a tyle suckled by negro
