# McKeithen Tells Negroes U.S. Will Solve Racial Problems

NEW YORK (AP) — Louisiana Gov. John J. McKeithen told an audience of Negro publishers Friday that the United States would solve its racial problems because "we're just stuck with each other and we just got to get along."

McKeithen is the first governor from the Deep South asked to address the National Newspaper Publishers Association, which represents 72 Negro weeklies. He said his administration was meeting Louisiana's racial problems with a program providing jobs and increased education and job opportunities for Negroes.

"We have no choice but to get along with each other and we think we are doing a good job," McKeithen said.

"None of us are completely satisfied but we are meeting the problem and facing up to it with all the resources that we have," the governor said.

McKeithen, 50, a Democrat, is regarded as a moderate on civil rights.
