

Ex-Governor A. B. Roman, a respectable and honored son of Louisiana, died suddenly in New Orleans on Sunday last, while passing from the house of his son-in-law, Mr. E. F. Lavillebeuvre, in Duane street. He had been in his usual health, and was about to pay a visit. A few yards from his home he fell and died instantly, evidently without pain or consciousness of the shock. He was a native of Louisiana, born in the parish St. Landry in 1795.
