

Archfoe of Kingfish Passes in Louisiana

BATON ROUGE, La., March 23 (AP).—J. Y. Sanders, former Governor of Louisiana, died Thursday night following an extended illness.

Sanders, 75 years old, was at one time an arch-foe of the late Huey P. Long, once swapping words and fisticuffs with the Kingfish in a New Orleans hotel.

They continued implacable political and personal enemies until Long's death in 1935.

Sanders served as Governor from 1908 to 1912. Two years later he was elected to Congress and served two terms.
