Gov. Allen died in Moxico. The remains were brought to New Orleans and placed in an ordinary temb in Washington Street Cometery. When the monument was in process of erection they were removed to another temb, and afterward reinterred beneath the monument. On the last occasion the bones were placed in a tin case, together

Capt. W. I. Hodgson, who has charge of the arrangements for the removal of the remains has had a conversation on the subject with Mr. Garlg, of Baton Rouge, a momber of the committee to receive thom.
It is proposed to cause the removal of the remains and meanment to Baton Rouge
