

*Funeral of ex Governor Isaac Johnson.*—The St Francisville Chronicle of Saturday last says:

The steamer Emperor brought the remains of the lamented Isaac Johnson, late Attorney-General of the State, to Bayou Sara on Thursday last. Appropriate committees were appointed to receive the remains. A committee of eight was appointed on the part of the Senate, and twenty-three on the part of the House of Representatives of the State, to accompany the remains to this place. When the boat landed, the body was conveyed to the hearse which was in waiting, and the procession being formed, proceeded to the late residence of the deceased, where the remains were left until Friday morning. At 10 o'clock on Friday, the different committees and a large number of our citizens assembled, and the remains were taken to the burying ground at the residence of Mrs. James P. Smith, followed by one of the largest processions we have ever witnessed.
