THIBODEAUX.

Rarber Is Being Held for the Shooting, Which Occurred at Early Hour in Morning.

Thibodeaux, La., May 18 .- A shooting af-

fray which resulted in the killing of ex-Lieut. Gov. Clay Knobloc occurred early this morning on Main street, and created a great-deal of excitement. The shooting was done by James Garault, a well-known barber. The trouble leading up to the killing

is practically unknown..., It was 7:30 o'clock when the killing occurred. It took place in a section of Main street that is usually crowded. The hour was early, though, and people were out. Several witnot many nesses of the shooting were found, but they refused to talk, further than to say that Garault shot in self-defense. The two men were seen talking together. when suddenly, ex-Lieut. Gov. Knobloc drew his revolver. It appeared that he experienced some trouble with the weapon,

and it failed to explode. Meantime Garault whipped out his revolver and opened fire on his adversary. That his aim was true is established by the autopsy held by the Coroner, who found five bullets had

entered the dead man's body. Either of the several wounds would have proved fainl. Ex-Lieut. Gov. Knoblock, it is understood. Severa did not get a chance to after Garault got his out.
Garault surrendered to the authorities, fand is being held for the present, but it is stated he will be allowed bond.
