DEATH. On the 18th ultimo, at Baton Rouge, Louisiana, in the 8th year of his age, General PHILEMON THOMAS, well known as a member of the Louisiana Legislature, member of

Congress, &cc. The deceased, we believe, was a netive of North Carolina, where, during the revolutionary war, he was engaged in many skirmishes with the British and tories. He resided some years in Kentucky, and was a member of the Legislature of that State; he afterwards removed to Louissana, and in 1810-11 headed the insurrection at Baton Rouge which threw off the yoke of Spain from West Florida. He was an
